

VITTORIA CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

Entry to the Campsite entails full acceptance without reservation and the obligation to fully comply with these regulations.

The Management holds the pitch holder responsible for all irregularities found among his/her family members and guests

ART. 1 ♦ Access to the Campsite ♦

- a) Entry must be authorized by the Management. Identity documents must always be presented for the registrations required by law and the identification wristbands provided by the Management must be worn. They must be kept on the wrist in order to circulate throughout the Campsite area, including the beach.
 - b) The management reserves the right to allow entry to visitors and daily guests, who must hand over their identity documents; after 1 hour of stay, they will be required to pay the fee.
 - d) Each Camper is required to make sure that his/her guests have been registered with the Management, and is responsible for their behavior.
 - e) Minors are not permitted to enter unless accompanied by an adult.
- The presence of unauthorized persons in the Campsite entails:
-violation of Public Safety Regulations (art. 109 TULPS); violation of the articles: 614 C.P. (trespassing), 633 C.P. (invasion of land and buildings), 624 C.P. (theft of services); offence of contractual fraud.

ART. 2 ♦ Pitch Occupation Rules ♦

- a) The pitch is assigned exclusively by the Campsite Management.
- b) For each pitch, only one party, one car, one power socket and one unit (Caravan, Camper or Tent) are allowed, with the addition of one AWNING and one KITCHEN TENT. Additional coverings are also permitted, provided that they comply with the characteristics of mobility and temporary nature, do not exceed a total maximum surface area of 40 sqm and a height of 3 m. Any other additional or non-conventional equipment is forbidden (e.g.: kitchen tents or awnings made of rigid materials, sheds, etc.).
- c) The PARKING SPACE is included within the pitch itself. There are also parking spaces available to everyone and it is forbidden to keep them occupied with chains, chairs, tarps or other objects.
- d) Campers are forbidden from delimiting pitches with fences, tarpaulins, enclosures or anything else. The Management, through the appointed staff, may remove the aforementioned works at any time and may also reduce the size of pitches exceeding 40 sqm. Campsite staff may remove anything which, in the opinion of the Management, undermines the safety of guests and facilities.
- e) It is forbidden to install tarps, guy ropes, brackets, structures or anything else on campsite structures and/or trees
- f) The pitch must be kept and left in the greatest order and cleanliness.
- g) At the end of the season the pitch must be completely cleared. It is forbidden to leave any type of package or bulky item inside the campsite. In any case, the Management is not responsible for equipment left on the site after the seasonal closure.

ART. 3 ♦ Payments and Departures ♦

- a) The stay is calculated based on the number of nights between the day of arrival and 13.00 on the day of departure. After that time, the calculation will be made based on the number of days.
- b) Any change of date must be communicated to the Management.
- c) In the event of cancellation of the booking, the deposit will be retained by the Management.

ART. 4 ♦ Rules of Conduct ♦

- a) Vehicle circulation: motor vehicles and bicycles must circulate inside the Campsite at moderate speed (MAX. 10 km per hour). Motor vehicles are not allowed to circulate: from 23.00 to 7.30 and from 13.00 to 15.00 (exclusion from the ban for Campsite Staff or maintenance workers authorized by the Management).
- b) Quiet and silence. Quiet hours are from 13.00 to 15.00 and from 23.00 to 7.30 (except for special entertainment evenings organized by the Management, which may continue beyond the indicated time). It is prohibited, during these hours, to disturb one's neighbours. Therefore any audiovisual equipment must be kept at low volume; shouting, noise, singing and games that may cause disturbance are prohibited.
- c) Children and minors. Children must be accompanied when using the various facilities and toilets. Children and minors must be supervised by their parents, who are fully and legally responsible for them.
- d) Beach: it is mandatory to comply with the Harbour Master's Office Regulations, the Municipal Ordinance and the Campsite Regulations. It is forbidden to stay and/or occupy the shoreline up to the limit of the campsite umbrellas

ART. 5 ♦ Animals ♦

- a) The acceptance of dogs or other animals must be agreed with the Management. Corso, Pitbull, Rottweiler, Doberman, Tosa Inu, Dogo Argentino, Bull Terrier, Mastiff, American Staffordshire Terrier, Molossers or Molosser crossbreeds in general and other dogs considered dangerous by the Management are not accepted. Dogs must be vaccinated according to regulations, kept on a leash, under the strict control of the owner, who must also collect their droppings. Animals are not allowed access to the beach. The animal's owner is solely responsible for any damage or injury that the animal may cause to things or people.

ART. 6 ♦ PROHIBITIONS ♦

IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN:

- to deposit non-conventional waste inside the Campsite (e.g. household appliances, mattresses, etc.) and waste of such size that it cannot fit into black bags; to throw waste on the grounds instead of in the appropriate containers.
- to dig holes or furrows in the pitches or move dunes;
- to damage the plants, flowers and equipment of the Campsite;
- to plant any type of plant, shrub or flower
- to wash dishes, laundry or anything else under the water taps
- to wash cars or other vehicles on the grounds; the Campsite has a dedicated area!
- to empty chemical toilets in unauthorized places;
- to install fixed connections between the water taps and the pitches: these will be removed by Campsite staff.
- to wash dogs in the sanitary facilities: the campsite has a dedicated area;
- to disperse on the ground detergents of any kind, harmful substances and anything or any product that may be harmful to vegetation or to the health and hygiene of people;

ART. 7 ♦ Liability ♦

The management is not liable:

- a) for any theft of objects or valuables not entrusted to and accepted for safekeeping by the Management.
- b) for damage to things or people caused by: other guests, fortuitous event or force majeure, natural disasters, falling pine cones, branches or trees, insects or other animals, epidemics including plant epidemics, and in any case by all causes not directly dependent on negligence of the company CO.DE.VI. Campeggio Vittoria.
- c) for damage due to structural failures of campsite facilities on which guy ropes, brackets, connections, tarps not owned by or in any case not installed by campsite staff have been applied

FIRE SAFETY REGULATIONS

Art.1 : All campers must have a suitable FIRE EXTINGUISHER inside their unit (dated no more than 6 months previously).

Art.2 : IT IS ABSOLUTELY FORBIDDEN:

- to light fires, use wood or charcoal Barbecues. The use of barbecues is permitted only with mobile gas appliances, with a suitable extinguisher placed in the immediate vicinity.
- to throw cigarette butts, use objects with open flames, candles, torches or similar items,- mosquito coils, citronella candles or other similar material.

Art. 3: the tarps used must be FIREPROOF; electric power cables must comply with EEC standards and be in good condition for use; they must not rest on the ground but must be overhead.

ART. 4: All campers are required to view the special maps placed at the entrance and throughout the Campsite area in order to identify escape routes, extinguisher points and safe meeting places.

ART. 5: in the event of the start of a fire, the management or Campsite staff must be notified immediately, and one must proceed without causing panic, along the escape routes (indicated on the special maps), towards the nearest safe places

ART. 6: It is forbidden to keep gas cylinders over 5 kg, spare cylinders, empty cylinders

SPECIAL PROHIBITIONS IN THE PINE FOREST AND ON THE SEAFRONT DUNES

Any type of tampering that involves a modification of the current state of the pine forest and dunes is absolutely forbidden, in particular digging holes or furrows in the pitches or moving and tampering with dunes, any morphological modification, damaging or planting plants, shrubs or flowers. In this regard we remind you that the Campsite's pine forest is located within a protected area and the incorrect behavior described above, in addition to violating the internal regulations of the Campsite and of the Po Delta Park, will also have criminal consequences borne directly by the responsible person.

The Campsite Staff, as far as possible, is entrusted with enforcing these Regulations. The Management reserves the right, at its discretion, to remove or not confirm the pitch for the following year for those guests who, because of their behavior, should prove unwelcome, damage the image of the campsite or otherwise disturb the harmony and spirit of the accommodation facility and the proper conduct of community life.
